Use of Cookies

Our website may place and access certain cookies on your web browser. We use cookies to facilitate and improve your experience of our site and to provide and improve our products and services. We have carefully chosen these cookies and have taken steps to ensure that your privacy and personal data is protected and respected at all times.

(1) About cookies

Cookies are files, often including unique identifiers, that are sent by web servers to web browsers, and which may then be sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server.



Cookies can be used by web servers to identify and track users as they navigate different pages on a website, and to identify users returning to a website.

(2) Cookies on this website

We will send to you cookies related to the following web analytics services that we have on our website:

- (2) Hubspot

These cookies are not integral to the functioning of our site and your use and experience of our site will not be impaired by blocking or deleting them. However, certain features of our site may not function fully or as intended.

(3) How we use cookies

Cookies do not contain any information that personally identifies you, but personal information that we store about you may be linked, by us, to the information stored in and obtained from cookies.

We may use the information we obtain from your use of our cookies for the following purposes:

- (1) to recognize your computer when you visit our website;
- (2) to improve the website's usability;
- (3) to analyze the use of our website;
- (4) in the administration of this website;
- (5) third party cookies.

When you use our website, you may also be sent third party cookies.

Our service providers may send you cookies. They may use the information they obtain from your use of their cookies:

- (1) to track your browser across multiple websites;
- (2) to build a profile of your web surfing;
- (3) to target advertisements which may be of particular interest to you.



(4) Blocking cookies

Most browsers allow you to refuse to accept cookies. For example:

- (1) in Internet Explorer you can refuse all cookies by clicking “Tools”, “Internet Options”, “Privacy”, and selecting “Block all cookies” using the sliding selector.
- (2) in Firefox you can block all cookies by clicking “Tools”, “Options”, and un-checking “Accept cookies from sites” in the “Privacy” box.

(5) Deleting cookies

You can also delete cookies already stored on your web browser:

- (1) in Internet Explorer, you must manually delete cookie files;
- (2) in Firefox, you can delete cookies by, first ensuring that cookies are to be deleted when you “clear private data” (this setting can be changed by clicking “Tools”, “Options” and “Settings” in the “Private Data” box) and then clicking “Clear private data” in the “Tools” menu.
